Larsmont CC Annual Meeting

The annual meeting of the Larsmont Community Club was held on Monday, May 15 beginning at 7:30 p.m. in the Little Red Schoolhouse.

Among the business of the meeting: a day and time was set for the Annual Picnic, Monday, August 28, 2006, from 5-7 p.m. at the Schoolhouse; a Painting Party was set for Friday-Sunday, August 25 through 27 to begin at 10 a.m., with paint being provided and folks encouraged to bring their own painting materials.

A motion was made, seconded and passed to inform members that if they hold functions and events at the Schoolhouse that generate money, such as a rummage sale, there will be a request for a 5% to 10% donation of their profits. The monies will go into the Building Fund, a fund that is used to continue the ongoing restoration of the Schoolhouse.

A suggestion was made at the meeting to ask LCC members to donate a minimum of \$25 toward the Building Fund. A donation of any amount will be accepted, but if someone donates \$100 or more, as a way of thanks there will be a plaque made with their name on it that will be placed in the Schoolhouse.

Any resident can be a member of the Larsmont Community Club with an annual

payment of \$10 in dues. Paid dues allows one free use of the Schoolhouse by the member. Dues and any donations for the Building Fund should be sent to LCC secretary **Marlys Wisch**, 489 Swanson Rd., Larsmont, MN 55616.
