Annual Business Meeting Slated for May 10 at Schoolhouse

The annual meeting of the Larsmont Community Club will be held at the Little Red Schoolhouse on **Thursday**, **May 10, 2007.** President Bill Tranah will call the meeting to order at 7 p.m.

One of major topics of discussion will be the annual community picnic and fund-raiser, setting a date for the annual event in 2007. Traditionally it has been held in August. Last year, the picnic was held near the end of August, but in previous years it was toward the beginning of the month.
